

FIND HELP IN YOUR COMMUNITY

United Way, one of the AFL-CIO's national partners, supports **2-1-1**, a free nationwide information and referral line that helps people find local resources they may be eligible to obtain 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

2-1-1 can be accessed by phone or computer. A toll-free call to 2-1-1 connects you to a community resource specialist in your area who can put you in touch with local organizations that provide critical services to eligible individuals, including:

- Supplemental food and nutrition programs;
- Shelter and housing options, and utilities assistance;
- Employment and education opportunities;
- Services for veterans;
- Health care and mental health services;
- And more.

Call 2-1-1 and speak with a live, highly trained service professional in your area from any cell phone or landline. All calls are private and confidential, and assistance is available in multiple languages.

PA Unemployment Compensation Information



You may be eligible for Unemployment Compensation during the Shutdown. The Pennsylvania Office of Unemployment Compensation has posted an alert for federal employees.

- **Employees that will not be reporting to work and will not be paid** by their federal employers. This group is considered to be furloughed and may be eligible for unemployment compensation.

TO FILE A CLAIM CALL 1-888-255-4728 OR GO ONLINE.

- **Employees that are required to report to work but will not be paid** for services performed after December 21, 2018. Because these individuals will be working full time, they will not be considered unemployed or furloughed. These employees are not eligible for unemployment compensation.
